DESCRIPTION

Seven generations of Kaikado master artisans have perfected the art of "chazutsu" storage canisters. Each handmade piece is available in polished brass or matte Urushi lacquer finish, with a tinplate lining and a snug-fit lid to preserve the freshness of loose tea, coffee beans, or ground coffee.

DIMENSIONS

Coffee Caddy: 4.25" dia x 7.5" H

Tea Caddy: 4.25" dia x 5" H

The soft matte black Urushi lacquer was made expressly for the NICOLEHOLLIS Collection as a nod to heritage Japanese craftmaking. The urushi lacquer process is completed entirely by a single craftsman, from the base preparation to the final finish, all by hand. Today, the number of skilled urushi craftsman in Japan is very limited, making this technique increasingly rare.

FINISH

Matte black

Scoop included with coffee caddy.

MATERIAL

Tinplate, brass, matte black Urushi

CARE

Each caddy is thoroughly sanitized prior to shipment, do not wash. Do not place the caddy in a refrigerator or freezer, as the material is sensitive to moisture and humidity. If the caddy comes into contact with water, please wipe it off immediately using a soft, dry cloth to prevent moisture spots.

When closing, align the joint line of the lid with that of the body. This allows air to be released slowly and the lid to close smoothly. Press the lid gently at the end to ensure a tight seal.

Urushi lacquer is durable and long-lasting when properly cared for, but as a natural material, it should be handled with consideration.

DESCRIPTION

CARE
