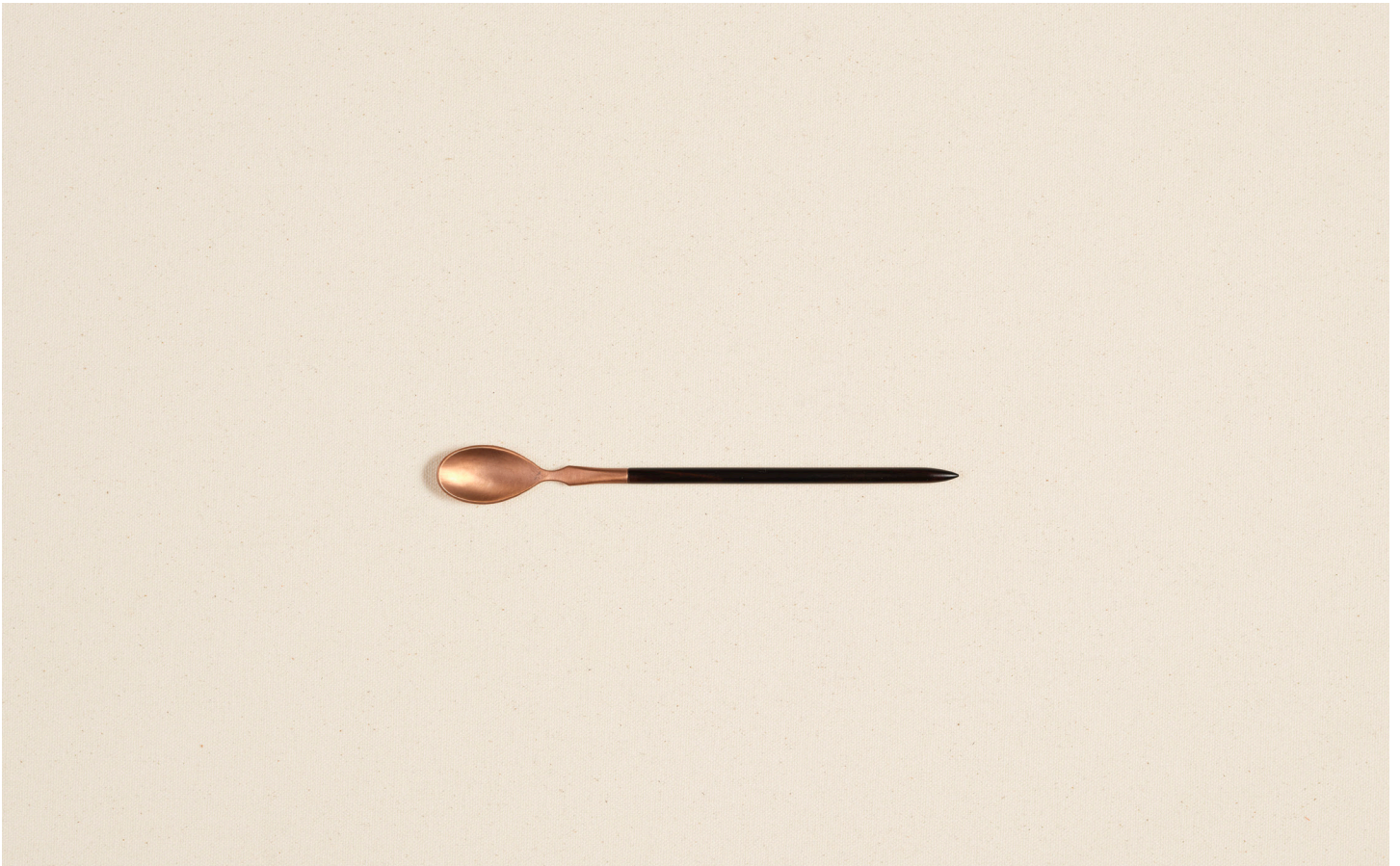

MATERIAL

Copper, wood

DESCRIPTION

Bearing the dimpled "tsuchime" finish associated with fine steel cutlery, this handmade copper spoon is exquisitely shaped and hammered into a symbol of both function and beauty. A tapered wood handle invites intentionality and consideration into each step of the incense ritual; it provides a delicate and deliberate vessel for nestling loose chips or botanicals into smoldering charcoal or onto a plate. The spoon can also be used to place loose tea into a pot for steeping.

Due to the handmade nature of this product, slight variations are to be expected.

CARE

Wash gently with mild dish soap and a soft sponge or cloth, then hand-dry. Do not use a dishwasher.
